

Basic Coverage

All students receive Yale Health Basic Coverage services free of charge.

Every student is covered at **no charge** for these services, even if you waive Yale Health coverage:

- Acute Care
- Gynecology
- Health Education Programs
- Inpatient Care
- Laboratory Services
- Mental Health & Counseling
- Nutrition Counseling
- Student Health

This includes the following:

- Physical exams
- Gynecological exams
- Pap smears
- Flu shots

CHOOSE EITHER

Hospitalization/ Specialty Care Coverage

Unless you waive coverage, you are automatically enrolled in and billed for Hospitalization/Specialty Care Coverage.

If you choose Yale Health Hospitalization/Specialty Care coverage, the services, listed at right, are covered. Services not available on-site are also covered with prior authorization by Yale Health.**

You can also receive free preventive immunizations at the Yale Health Center and free generic oral contraceptives from the Yale Health Center Pharmacy.

PRESCRIPTION DRUGS

Prescription drugs are covered if medically necessary and FDA approved subject to a 3-tier copay structure when purchased at the Yale Health Center Pharmacy. The copays are as follows, please refer to the Yale Health Drug List for specific drug information, yalehealth.yale.edu/druglist:

- ◆ \$10.00 for a generic drug, up to a 30-day supply
- ◆ \$30.00 for a preferred brand name drug, up to a 30-day supply
- ◆ \$45.00 for a non-preferred drug, up to a 30-day supply

Waiving Coverage

Waiving coverage allows you to utilize alternate coverage and to opt out of Yale Health Hospitalization/Specialty Care Coverage.

The University requires all degree candidate students who are half-time or more to have hospitalization and specialty care coverage.

All students are covered by Yale Health Basic.

In addition to this coverage, you can:

- 1 Purchase Yale Health Hospitalization/Specialty coverage
- 2 Have coverage by being a dependent on someone else's coverage
- 3 Purchase other coverage on your own

As you consider your options, keep in mind that many other (non-Yale Health) plans will not cover routine specialty care such as allergy shots and physical therapy rendered while you are away from home. **Please check with your other plan about coverage of medical services out of their service area.**

Additionally, drug cards from other insurance plans are not accepted at the Yale Health Pharmacy as we do not participate in other insurance networks. Check with your insurance plan to locate pharmacies that participate in your plan.

HOW TO WAIVE

You may decline enrollment in Yale Health Hospitalization/Specialty Care coverage by submitting a waiver online at yhpstudentwaiver.yale.edu. Waiver forms must be submitted annually by:

September 15 for the full year or fall term
January 31 for the spring term

Care & Services

SAME DAY CARE

To accommodate immediate health issues, appointments are available for same day care based on need. Please make sure to call ahead.

PRIMARY CARE CLINICIANS

All Yale students are designated with a primary care clinician (PCC) in the Department of Student Health. All women are also designated with a PCC in the Department of Obstetrics & Gynecology.

SEXUAL HEALTH

Routine and problem-based testing, counseling and care can be accessed in Student Health and Ob/Gyn.

STUDENT FAMILY COVERAGE

A student may enroll a spouse/civil union partner and/or dependent children (under age 26). Applications must be submitted annually and received by **September 15** for the full year or fall term and **January 31** for the spring term.

MENTAL HEALTH & COUNSELING

All Yale students may make appointments for mental health and counseling services directly with Mental Health & Counseling. No referral is needed.

VACCINATIONS

Hospitalization/Specialty Coverage includes free preventive immunizations at the Yale Health Center. Travel vaccines and pre-entrance requirements are not covered, but are available on a fee-for-service basis.
