Organization Description:

Seeds of Success is a program for middle school students in New Haven who want to explore science, technology, engineering, math and medicine (STEMM). Through hands-on workshops, inspiring mentors, and fun leadership activities, students build confidence and discover how STEMM connects to their lives and communities.

This program brings together mentors from a variety of STEMM backgrounds, Yale student-led organizations, and diverse program in an effort to make Yale spaces and resources available to local students.

GPE Fellow Responsibilities:

- * Support the planning and execution of program activities and events.
- * Help establish and maintain strong relationships with mentors.
- * Facilitate the mentor-mentee matching process and monitor the progress of mentoring relationships to ensure program goals are being met.
- * Coordinate logistical aspects of events and activities, including attendance tracking, transportation, catering, and on-site support.
- * Assist in facilitating program activities that immerse students in specific STEMM topics.
- * Serve as a liaison between the mentor group and the Seeds of Success team, ensuring clear communication and smooth collaboration.

- * Social and cultural competence and a strong interest in developing effective mentoring skills.
