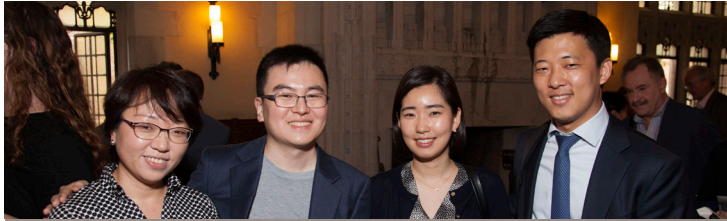

HEALTHCARE COVERAGE

All Yale GSAS students can enroll their legally married S-P and/or any dependent children up to age 26 in Yale Health (YH) to access high-quality, convenient health care services.

Review the Yale Health premium rates then complete the required enrollment form by Sept. 15 annually. PhD students are eligible for GSAS Health Award for half the cost of Yale Health coverage for a legally married S-P. PhD students with children are eligible for free YH children's coverage and up to \$4,500/year in GSAS Family Support subsidy. gsas.yale.edu

Dental & Vision Plans

GSAS students may enroll themselves and their S-P in optional student dental and vision plans from outside providers, for a fee, by Sept. 15 each year. gradprofidenteye.yale.edu

S-P Privileges Student Spouse Sponsored ID (SID)

All legally married or civil union S-P of Yale GSAS students are eligible for a Yale Access Badge (spouse ID) through the Sponsored ID (SID) process. Privileges include:

- Membership discounts to Yale's athletic facilities and classes
- Library access & borrowing privileges
- Many workshops & student programs
- Free admission to the Peabody Museum
- Ticket Discounts for Yale Rep Theatre and guest tickets for Yale athletic events
- Access certain Yale buildings & Yale NetID systems, as needed (Grad Apts., Yale Connect)



Domestic Partner Resources

Domestic partners of Yale students who are not married can access certain resources. They do not receive a Yale SID badge, but do have:

- Discounts for tickets to the Yale Repertory Theatre and for Yale athletic events
- Discounted memberships to the Payne Whitney Gym and Yale Golf Course through student partner's purchases
- Free and paid privileges at Yale's libraries
- Yale Shuttle - free for all!

HOUSING

- Yale graduate housing offers on-campus apartments suitable for a student with S-P and/or kids. Apply online starting April 23 as units are limited.

Auditing Courses

S-P of full-time students may informally audit or sit in on courses without charge in Yale College and the Graduate School, pending approval of the instructor and the relevant academic department. In most cases, the professors can arrange "guest" access to online course materials.

S-P can also apply to formally audit and receive credit or official transcripts for many Yale courses; tuition charges apply for each course attended for credit or official audit.
